RSACC is a charity run by and for women. We work to end rape and sexual violence by supporting and empowering women and girls in Darlington and County Durham.

We offer free, safe support to survivors 13 and above who have experienced any form of sexual abuse at any time in their lives.

Our anonymous and confidential Helpline provides a safe space for anyone who has been directly or indirectly affected by sexual violence, abuse or domestic violence. This includes family or friends who can call us to better understand how we help survivors. We can also support them too.

If you call our local Helpline you will be supported by trained women who are there to listen and support without judgement. As well as emotional support, they will be able to explore what practical support might be available to you and what your options might be. But it is totally up to you to choose what might happen next. Calls can last up to an hour, but you can call as many times as you need.

Our callers tell us that having a friendly, understanding and reassuring person to talk to can help them.

Calls to our Helpline are anonymous unless the caller chooses to identify themselves. Conversations are not recorded.
