We offer free, safe support to all survivors 13 and above who have experienced any form of sexual abuse at any time in their lives. If you need to talk to someone in confidence about sexual abuse, we are here for you.





We are aware that there is a lack of specialist services just for men and boys but, we can offer you a range of services to support you and also signpost to other organisations that can help male sexual violence survivors.



# Supporting male sexual violence survivors

We recognise that men and boys experience, are affected and are at risk of rape and sexual violence. We therefore offer support to male survivors through a number of our services. Men and boys can access our counselling, our Independent Sexual Violence Advisor (ISVA) service and our Helpline.

# Counselling

Our specialist counselling is offered to men and boys aged over 13. You can access it at any time after your abuse has occurred. It is available at a variety of locations across Darlington and County Durham.

### **ISVA Service**

Our ISVA service offers nonjudgemental, practical and emotional support to survivors of sexual abuse who are thinking of reporting to the police or who have reported to the police.

# **Confidential Helpline**

We have a telephone support line where male survivors can call for support and one of our highly trained team will be there to listen empathetically and without judgement.
